STATEMENT OF DECISION

SUBJECT: **COMMEMORATIVE GREEN PLAQUE TO THE IVY RESTAURANT**

Notice is hereby given that the Cabinet Member for Built Environment, has made the following executive decision on the above mentioned subject for the reasons set out below.

Summary of Decision

That the nomination for a Westminster Commemorative Green Plaque for the Centenary of *The Ivy* Restaurant at 1-5 West Street, be approved, subject to sponsorship in full.

Reasons for Decision

In June 2015 *The Ivy* opened its doors to the public once again following a five month closure for a major refurbishment which has seen one of London's most iconic restaurants enter a new chapter, ahead of its centenary celebrations in 2017.

Councillor Davis declared that he knows the Directors of Caprice Holdings who own The Ivy and has received hospitality from them over several years.
