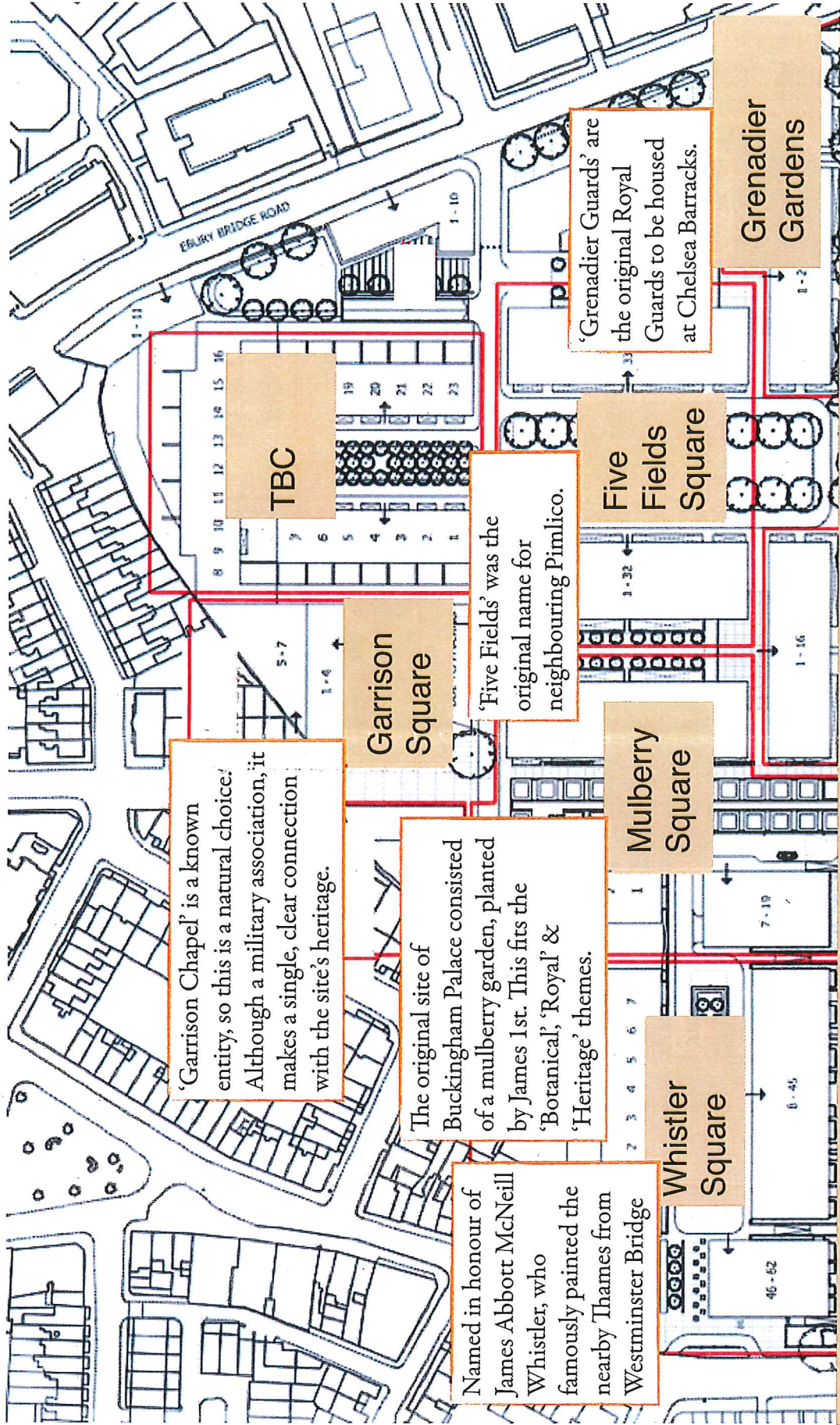


Primary Location Names : Suggestions and rationales, for consideration



'Garrison Chapel' is a known entity, so this is a natural choice. Although a military association, it makes a single, clear connection with the site's heritage.

The original site of Buckingham Palace consisted of a mulberry garden, planted by James 1st. This fits the 'Botanical', 'Royal' & 'Heritage' themes.

Named in honour of James Abbott McNeill Whistler, who famously painted the nearby Thames from Westminster Bridge
