

Application for a Premises Licence - Variation

To vary the existing premises licence so as to: 1. Incorporate the licensable activity of 'Films' within public areas to conform to existing regulated hours and within private bedrooms available 24 hours a day. 2. To extend the terminal hour for sale by retail of alcohol and late night refreshment in the area known as Brook Street Bar, only, by one hour to 02:00 Wednesday to Saturday and to 00:30 on Sunday's.

The Licensing Authority must receive representations in writing by the date given above. The Licensing Authority will have regard to any such representation in considering the application. It is an offence, under section 158 of the Licensing Act 2003, to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in or in connection with an application for premises licence and the maximum fine on being convicted of such an offence is £5000.
