STATEMENT OF DECISION

SUBJECT: BSF Delegations, Pimlico School TUPE Indemnity and Related Matters

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Legal and Administrative Services has made the following executive decision under Standing Order 40 on the above mentioned subject for the reason set out below following the circulation of a report to the Members of the Cabinet Urgency Committee.

Summary of Decision:

- 1. That the report is urgent for the purposes of Standing Order 40 (5) for the reasons given in paragraph 4.2 of the report and that its contents are confidential pursuant to paragraphs 3 and 5 of Schedule 12A to the Local Government Act 1972 because it contains information relating to the financial or business affairs of the City Council and information in respect of which a claim to legal professional privilege could be maintained in legal proceedings.
- 2. That the Director of BSF Designate be delegated authority to take all decisions necessary to progress the BSF programme, subject to such consultation with the Cabinet Member for Children's Services, and reporting to the BSF Cabinet Committee, as may be appropriate.
- 3. That a TUPE Indemnity be given and that legacy assets be transferred to the Trustees of the Pimlico Academy, as set out in paragraph 3 of the report.
- 4. That Officers proceed as regards related property and contractual issues, on the basis set out in paragraph 2 of the report, and that the Chief Executive be authorised to agree all matters of detail and consequential matters in this respect.

Reason for Decision:

Further Officer delegations are needed to progress the Council's BSF programme in a timely and efficient manner. Urgent authority is also needed to resolve outstanding issues in respect of the proposed Pimlico Academy.
