STATEMENT OF DECISION

SUBJECT: RENEWAL OF NUISANCE VEHICLE PUBLIC SPACE PROTECTION ORDER 2024

Notice is hereby given that the Cabinet Member for Children and Public Protection has made the following executive decision on the above mentioned subject for the reasons set out below.

The Cabinet Member is asked to approve a new PSPO for the control of anti-social vehicle use until 29 December 2027.

Summary of Decision: The Cabinet Member for Children and Public Protection has taken the decision to approve the renewal of the Public Space Protection Order to tackle anti-social vehicle use on the same terms as the current order.

Reason for Decision: The Council has had statutory powers to create a PSPO since 2014. PSPOs are designed to counteract activity or behaviour which may have a detrimental effect on the quality of life of those in the locality; is, or is likely to be, persistent or continuing in nature; and justifies the reasons imposed. The Cabinet Member approved the renewal of the order to ensure that anti-social driving in this area of the borough can continue to be tackled.
