## Summary

An application was made by the Metropolitan Police Service on 4<sup>th</sup> January 2017 to review the premises licence for Rah Rah Rooms, 215-217 Piccadilly, London, W1J 9HF under the Section 53A(1)(b) of the Licensing Act 2003 (premises associated with serious crime or disorder).

## Options

The Committee after considering this report and the evidence presented at the hearing may take such interim steps as it considers necessary for the promotion of the licensing objectives. These steps are:

- (a) modification of the conditions of the premises licence (modify, delete or add conditions);
- (b) to exclude the sale by retail of alcohol from the scope of the licence;
- (c) to remove the designated premises supervisor;
- (d) to suspend the licence;

## 1. Summary of review application

- 1.1 On Sunday 1st January 2017, New Years Eve, at approximately 00:33 hours, serious crime and disorder took place at the Rah Rah Room, whereby three males sustained serious stab wounds.
- 1.2 Disorder broke out when two males began to dance with a female on the dance floor. Another male, who was in a group with this female punched one of these males.
- 1.3 CCTV shows for the next two minutes people from both groups moving around and interacting with each other. At 00:36 hours, another fight begins between the two groups. The groups are seen using bottles to assault each other.
- 1.4 Security arrive and manage to separate two groups from one end of the club to the other.
- 1.5 Approximately ten minutes later two unknown males approached one of the groups and another fight starts . These two males use bottles to assault the group. Both groups-disperse all over the venue with people running to escape and with others fighting back. The males fighting back are seen on CCTV using bottles, tables and other items of furniture to throw . This fighting continues up the stairs as people are trying to escape.
- 1.6 It is at this point that the first male who threw the punch in the initial altercation is seen clutching his abdomen. He sits down in the seating area where some females assist him. He lifts his shirt and takes it off to reveal blood on his back and his shirt.
- 1.7 The two unknown males that attacked the group in the second incident are seen on CCTV running up the stairs and into the fire escape. They then leave the club via the back door onto Jermyn Street, W1.
- 1.8 Approximately seven minutes later, the male with blood on his back is seen with security being led out the back exit onto Jermyn Street where he is treated by paramedics who arrive. Another male is also led out to be seen by paramedics.
- 1.9 Many Police units soon arrive and it is confirmed that both these males received stab wounds to their abdomens.
- 1.10 There was a third male who was injured and his injuries were treated by staff at the venue .

- 1.11 No arrests were made at the time as security did not detain anyone long enough. Police were called at 00:50 hours. The first incident happened 17 minutes previous. This was sufficient time for Police to arrive on scene, which could have prevented the serious disorder and injuries that were sustained.
- 1.12 One of the males injured was 17 years old and therefore should not have been inside the venue.
- 1.13 On the 3rd September 2016 Rah Rah Room there was more serious crime and disorder at the venue, whereby a male was stabbed in his leg. There were failings by the venue in terms of searching, detaining people and crime scene preservation. CCTV footage showed staff cleaning the scene and mopping up blood.
- 1.14 Police Licensing engaged with the venue and took a stepped approached to work with them in order to prevent further incidents. This resulted in Police Licensing offering a number of conditions to go on their premises licence.
- 1.15 The venue refused to accept some of the conditions asked for, namely an ID scan system and search arches . Had this measures been accepted, it could have prevented this disorder from happening.
- 1.16 Since this incident occurred Police Licensing have had no contact with the DPS, Tony Flynn. On New Years Eve when Police arrived on scene, there was no sign of the DPS and the Operations Director, Arran Curtis was the point of contact.
- 1.17 The nature of this crime and disorder is so serious that it represents significant failings in upholding and promoting the Licensing objectives. This incident posed great risk to members of the public within the venue and it's members of staff. CCTV shows staff jumping over the bar to hide and protect themselves.
- 1.18 Copies of the application and evidence have been served on responsible authorities, the licensee and their representatives.
- 1.19 CCTV of the incident will be made available at the Committee Hearing.

#### 2. Submissions from Licensee

2.1 Due to the short notice of the hearing to consider interim steps it has not been possible for the licensee to submit anything in time for the publication of this report.

## 3. Interim steps

3.1 Under the provisions of section 53A(2)(a) of the Act the Licensing Authority must within 48 hours of receiving the review application consider whether it is necessary to take interim steps pending the determination of a full review of the premises licence.

## 4. Options

- 4.1 The Authority must, having regard to the application, take such interim steps as it considers necessary for the promotion of the licensing objectives. The steps are:
  - (a) to modify the conditions of the premises licence (modify, delete or add conditions);
  - (b) to exclude sale of alcohol from the scope of the licence;
  - (c) to remove the designated premises supervisor;
  - (d) suspend the licence

#### Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions

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- 1. No supply of alcohol may be made at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of this licence.
- 2. No supply of alcohol may be made at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or the personal licence is suspended.
- 3. Every supply of alcohol under this licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
- 4. (1) The responsible person must ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
  - (2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises—
  - (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to;
    - drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
    - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
  - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
  - (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less in a manner which carries a significant risk of undermining a licensing objective;
  - (d) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner;
  - (e) dispensing alcohol directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).
- 5. The responsible person must ensure that free potable water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.
- 6. (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
  - (2) The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.

- (3) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either—
  - (a) a holographic mark, or
  - (b) an ultraviolet feature.
- 7. The responsible person must ensure that—
  - (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures—
    - (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
    - (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
    - (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml;
  - (b) these measures are displayed in a menu, price list or other printed material which is available to customers on the premises; and
  - (c) where a customer does not in relation to a sale of alcohol specify the quantity of alcohol to be sold, the customer is made aware that these measures are available.

A responsible person in relation to a licensed premises means the holder of the premise licence in respect of the premises, the designated premises supervisor (if any) or any individual aged 18 or over who is authorised by either the licence holder or designated premises supervisor. For premises with a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity that which enables him to prevent the supply of alcohol.

- 8(i) A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.
- 8(ii) For the purposes of the condition set out in paragraph 8(i) above -
  - "duty" is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979;
  - (b) "permitted price" is the price found by applying the formula -

P ≔ D+(DxV)

Where -

- (i) P is the permitted price,
- (ii) D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and
- (iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;
- (c) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence -
  - (i) the holder of the premises licence,

- (ii) the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
- (iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence;
- (d) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and
- (e) "value added tax" means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994.
- 8(iii). Where the permitted price given by Paragraph 8(ii)(b) above would (apart from this paragraph) not be a whole number of pennies, the price given by that sub-paragraph shall be taken to be the price actually given by that sub-paragraph rounded up to the nearest penny.
- 8(iv). (1) Sub-paragraph 8(iv)(2) below applies where the permitted price given by Paragraph 8(ii)(b) above on a day ("the first day") would be different from the permitted price on the next day ("the second day") as a result of a change to the rate of duty or value added tax.
  - (2) The permitted price which would apply on the first day applies to sales or supplies of alcohol which take place before the expiry of the period of 14 days beginning on the second day.
- 9. All persons guarding premises against unauthorised access or occupation or against outbreaks of disorder or against damage (door supervisors) must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

#### Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the operating Schedule

- 10. From 21:00 until 30 minutes after close of business, a minimum of 2 SIA licensed door staff to be stationed at the entrance on Piccadilly whose tasks will include:
  - Reminding customers that this is a residential area and to respect the needs of neighbours
  - To maintain an orderly queue where necessary
  - To ask customers leaving the premises to do so quickly and quietly
- 11. No noise shall emanate from the premises nor vibration be transmitted through the structure of the premises which gives rise to a nuisance.
- 12. The number of persons accommodated at any one time (excluding staff) shall not exceed the following:

Mezzanine - 100 Basement Auditorium - 300.

With a maximum capacity of 400.

- 13. A staff member from the premises who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV system shall be on the premises at all times when the premises is open. This staff member must be able to provide a Police or authorised council officer copies of recent CCTV images or data with the absolute minimum of delay when requested.
- 14. An incident log shall be kept at the premises, and made available on request to an authorised officer of the City Council or the Police, which will record the following: (a) all crimes reported to the venue
  - (b) any complaints received regarding crime and disorder
  - (c) any incidents of disorder

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- (d) any faults in the CCTV system
- (e) any refusal of the sale of alcohol
- (f) any visit by a relevant authority or emergency service
- 15. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system as per the minimum requirements of the Westminster Police Licensing Team. All entry and exit points will be covered enabling frontal identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV system shall continually record whilst the premises is open for licensable activities and during all times when customers remain on the premises. All recordings shall be stored for a minimum period of 31 days with date and time stamping. Viewing of recordings shall be made available immediately upon the request of Police or authorised officer throughout the preceding 31 day period.
- 16. After 23.00hrs all persons entering or re-entering the premises shall be searched by an SIA-trained member of staff and monitored and recorded by the premises CCTV system. The searching will be supplemented by the use of two functional metal detecting wands.
- 17. After 23.00hrs all security employed at the premises shall wear high viz jackets or tabards
- 18. Patrons permitted to temporarily leave and then re-enter the premises, e.g. to smoke, shall not be permitted to take drinks or glass containers with them.

In the event that a serious assault is committed on the premises (or appears to have 19. been committed) the management will immediately ensure that:

(a) The Police (and where appropriate, the London Ambulance Service) are called without delay, using emergency telephone number 999;

(b) All measures that are reasonably practicable are taken to apprehend any suspects pending the arrival of the Police;

(c) As is reasonably practicable, the crime scene is preserved so as to enable a full forensic investigation to be carried out by the Police; and

(d) Such other measures are taken (as appropriate) to fully protect the safety of all persons present on the premises."

'Serious assault' includes (but is not limited to) any assault in which emergency medical treatment is required and any assault in which a weapon is used.

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Annex 3 - Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

- 20. There shall be no admissions to the premises after 02:30 hours.
- 21. No children under the age of 16 shall be permitted on the premises after 21:00 hours.
- 22. No children under the age of 14 shall be admitted on the premises.
- 23. No striptease, no nudity and all persons to be decently attired at all times.
- 24. The highway in the vicinity of the premises shall be swept at regular intervals and also at the close of business. Litter and sweepings collected shall be stored in accordance with the approved refuse storage arrangement.
- 25. No unauthorised advertisements of any kind shall be inscribed or affixed upon the surface of the highway, or upon any building, structure, works, street furniture, tree or any other property, or is distributed to the public, that advertises or promotes the establishment, its premises or any of its events, facilities, goods and services.
- 26. No payment shall be made by or on behalf of the premises for distribution of flyers or tickets within public areas in the Licensing District of Westminster.
- 27. An attendant shall be on duty in the cloakroom during the whole time that it is in use.
- 28. A daily log is to be maintained to ensure that any capacity limit set for the various floors and the overall capacity of the premises is recorded hourly and can be properly monitored. Information regarding the capacity will be given to an authorised officer or Police Officer on request.
- 29. On any evening where the premises or part of the premises are open for public music, dance and entertainment, alcohol may not be sold or supplied to persons admitted after 23:00 other than to:
  - (a) Persons taking a table meal; or

Service -

(b) Persons who have paid a minimum admission fee of at least £5 for music, dancing and entertainment (not to be credited against consumables)

(c) Persons who have paid a minimum annual membership fee of at least £150 payable in advance for music, dancing and entertainment (not to be credited against consumables) and their bona fide guests. A list of all people who have paid an annual membership fee and their guests will be held at reception for inspection by relevant authority; or

(d) Persons given free membership and their bona fide guests where there has been an interval of at least 24 hours between application for membership. A list of all persons who have free membership will be held at reception for inspection by the relevant authority; or

(e) Persons who are bona fide guests of the license holder or management, a list of whom shall be kept at reception for inspection by the relevant authorities; or (f) Artistes and persons employed by the premises; or

(g) Persons attending at private function; the function organiser's name and address to be kept at reception for inspection by the relevant authorities

- 30. Substantial food and non-intoxicating beverages, including water, shall be available throughout the permitted hours in all parts of the premises where intoxicating liquor is sold and supplied for consumption on the premises.
- 31. The sale of intoxicating liquor must be ancillary to the use of the premises for music and dancing and substantial refreshment.

- 32. No payment shall be made by or on behalf of the licensees to any persons bringing customers into the premises.
- 33. A noise limiter located in a separate and remote lockable cabinet from the volume control must be fitted to the musical amplification system set at a level determined by and to the satisfaction of an authorised officer of the Environmental Health Service's Community Protection Department so as to ensure that no noise nuisance is caused to local residents or businesses. The operational panel of the noise limiter shall then be secured to the satisfaction of officers from the Environmental Health Service. The keys securing the noise limiter cabinet shall be held by the applicant only, and shall not be accessed by any other person. The limiter shall not be altered without prior agreement with the Environmental Health Service.
- 34. No alteration or modification to any existing sound system(s) should be effected without prior knowledge of an authorised Officer of the Environmental Health Service.
- 35. Any additional sound generating equipment shall not be used on the premises without being routed through the sound limiter device.
- 36. All entrance doors to be kept closed except for people's immediate access and egress.
- 37. No speakers shall be located in the entrance area.
- 38. All refuse will be paid, properly presented and placed on the street 30 minutes before any agreed collection time. Every endeavour will be made to prevent refuse being left on the street for more than 2.5 hours.
- No bottles will be moved, removed or placed in outside areas between 23:00 and 08:00.
- 40. No persons shall give at the premises any exhibition, demonstration or performance of hypnotism, mesmerism or any similar act or process which produces or is intended to produce in any other person any form of induced sleep or trance in which susceptibility of the mind of that person to suggestion or direction is increased or intended to be increased.

NOTE: This rule does not apply to exhibitions given under the provisions of Section 2(1A) and 5 of the Hypnotism Act 1952.

- 41. The approved arrangements at the premises, including means of escape provisions, fire warning and fire fighting equipment, the electrical installation and mechanical equipment, shall at all material times be maintained in good condition and full working order.
- 42. The certificates listed below shall be submitted to the Licensing Authority annually.

(a) Any emergency lighting battery or system(b) Any electrical installation(c) Any fire alarm system

- 43. The means of escape provided for the premises shall be maintained unobstructed, free of trip hazards, be immediately available and clearly identified in accordance with the plans provided.
- 44. All exit doors shall be available at all times without he use of a key, code, card or similar means.
- 45. All fire doors shall be maintained effectively self-closing and not half open other than by an approved device.

- 46 Fire doors to ducts, service shafts and cupboards shall be kept locked shut.
- 47. The edges of the treads and steps and stairways shall be maintained so as to be conspicuous.
- 48. Only hanging, curtains, upholstery and temporary decorations, complying with the relevant British Standard shall be used. Where necessary these shall be periodically tested for flame resistance and re-treated as necessary.
- 49. Curtains and hangings shall be arranged so as not to obstruct fire safety signs, fire extinguishers or other fire fighting equipment.
- 50. Staff with specific responsibilities in the vent of fire or other emergency, together with deputies, shall receive training and written instruction appropriate to their role.
- 51. Any special effects or mechanical installations shall be arranged and sorted so as to minimise any risk to the safety of those using the premises. The following special effects will only be used on 10 days prior notice being given to the Licensing Authority where consent has not previously been given.

- pyrotechnics and fog generators
- firearms





	On Sunday 1st January 2017, New Years Eve, at approximately 00:33 hours, serious crime and disorder took place at Rah Rah Room, whereby three males sustained serious stab wounds.
	Disorder broke out when two males began to dance with a female on the dance floor. Another male, who was was in a group with this female punched one of these males.
	CCTV shows for the next two minutes people from both groups moving around and interacting with each other. At 00:36 hours, another fight begins between the two groups. The groups are seen using bottles to assault each other.
	Security arrive and manage to separate two groups from one end of the club to the other.
	Approximately ten minutes later two unknown males approached one of the groups and another fight starts. These two males use bottles to assault the group. Both groups disperse all over the venue with people running to escape and with others fighting back. The males fighting back are seen on CCTV using bottles, tables and other items of furniture to throw. This fighting continues up the stairs as people are trying to escape.
	It is at this point that the first male who threw the punch in the initial altercation is seen clutching his abdomen. He sits down in the seating area where some females assist him. He lifts his shirt and takes it off to reveal blood on his back and his shirt.
	The two unknown males that attacked the group in the second incident are seen on CCTV running up the stairs and into the fire escape. They then leave the club via the back door onto Jermyn Street, W1.
	Approximately seven minutes later, the male with blood on his back is seen with security being led out the back exit onto Jermyn Street where he is treated by paramedics who arrive. Another male is also led out to be seen by paramedics.
	Many Police units soon arrive and it is confirmed that both these males received stab wounds to their abdomens.
ĺ	There was a third male who was injured and his injuries were treated by staff at the venue.
	No arrests were made at the time as security did not detain anyone long enough. Police were called at 00:50 hours. The first incident happened 17 minutes previous. This was sufficient time for Police to arrive on scene, which could have prevented the serious disorder and injuries that were sustained.
	One of the males injured was 17 years old and therefore should not have been inside the venue.
	On the 3rd September 2016 Rah Rah Room there was more serious crime and disorder at the venue, whereby a male was stabbed in his leg. There were failings by the venue in terms of searching, detaining people and crime scene preservation. CCTV footage showed staff cleaning the scene and mopping up blood.
ļ	Police Licensing engaged with the venue and took a stepped approached to work with them in order to prevent further incidents. This resulted in Police Licensing offering a number of conditions to go on their premises licence.
	The venue refused to accept some of the conditions asked for, namely an ID scan system and search arches. Had this measures been accepted, it could have prevented this disorder from happening.
	Since this incident occurred Police Licensing have had no contact with the DPS, Tony Flynn. On New Years Eve when Police arrived on scene, there was no sign of the DPS and the Operations Director, Arron Curtis was the point of contact.
	The nature of this crime and disorder is so serious that it represents significant failings in upholding and promoting the Licensing objectives. This incident posed great risk to members of the public within the venue and it's members of staff. CCTV shows staff jumping over the bar to hide and protect themselves.
	The Metropolitan Police request the Licensing Sub Committee consider immediate suspension of the premises licence pending a full hearing where the police will seek full revocation of the premises licence. Signature of applicant
