• For premises for the provision of other licensable activities:

Friday and Saturday: 09.00 to midnight Sundays immediately prior to Bank Holidays: 09.00 to midnight Other Sundays: 09.00 to 22.30 Monday to Thursday: 09.00 to 23.30.
