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## BT Openreach Street Work Activity

Since the submission of the Environment Policy and Scrutiny Committee Report we would like to provide supplementary information with regards to recent applications Westminster City Council have received from BT Openreach for street works and road closures in order for cabinets within Westminster to be upgraded.
