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1. Executive Summary

On Thursday 24th July, Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust published their clinical strategy in response to Shaping a Healthier Future; the reconfiguration of hospitals and healthcare provision in North West London.

As a result of Shaping a Healthier Future, it has been long known that St Mary's Hospital would expand its range of services and become the Trust's 'hot site' of emergency and acute medicine; including the major trauma centre, hyper-acute stroke unit and a range of complementary clinical services associated with being a major, acute hospital (A&E, ICU, HDU et al). However, the services at each of the sites would be changed as a result of this centralisation and re-organisation of services across Imperial's three sites.

The vision for the three hospitals is as follows:

- **St Mary's Hospital** - **Major Hospital**
- **Hammersmith Hospital** - **Specialist Hospital**
- **Charing Cross Hospital** - **Local Hospital**

2. Key Matters for the Committee's Consideration

- To assess whether the proposals outlined in Imperial College Healthcare NHS Trust's Clinical Strategy (Appendix 1) aligns with the NHS North West London reconfiguration entitled 'Shaping a Healthier Future'; and thus does not require a Section 244 consultation.
