Subject: City for All

Background and towards a new strategy

The Council adopted its City for All strategy in March 2015, for delivery over three years.

Following the election of the new Leader in January 2017, the strategy was updated to focus on three new priorities including putting civic leadership and responsibility at the heart of all we do, promoting opportunity and fairness across the city and setting the standards for a world class city.

Following the election of a new administration in 2018, the Council will launch a new and refreshed strategy for the Council term ahead.

Discussion have been on going with Cabinet as to the shape and purpose of this new strategy and, following debate at Full Council, a strategy will be published to stakeholders.

Achievements of City for All

Over the last year, we have delivered significant advancements for the people who live, work and visit Westminster. Achievements include:

- significant advancements to help improve our air quality
- a new fund for community groups to apply to for local projects
- more opportunities for people to come together to celebrate diversity
- new and improved facilities and assets for the benefit of the community
- support for EU residents living in our city
- first community contribution scheme launched in the country
- more apprenticeship opportunities with Westminster employers
