Thank you for your e mail below and the attachments contained therein. We have not had much time to review these in advance of the hearing scheduled for Thursday. I do make the following initial comments and I use this response to put the committee on notice that if, on the full reading of the details, I need to that I would want to be able to make further comments at the meeting itself;

1) The attached letter of 24/04/19 –this differs to the actual letter received by hand delivery at the Flat, please see the copy which I provided to you and which has been sent to the committee. The version we rec'd did not say "yours sincerely" or have the contact number or e mail contained within it. That made it only possible to respond by written communication to the version we received. We did that on 26/04/19 and have still rec'd no response. Again I did provide a copy of our written response to yourselves and you kindly did forward that to the committee. We are concerned that the Committee has been provided with an inaccurate view of what was sent to us.

2) To confirm we have never rec'd a letter dated 28/03/19. This is the first we have seen such a letter and to my knowledge the other residents have not received such a letter. ....has specifically confirmed to me he received no such letter. If we had received such a letter we would have reached out to discuss the matter via the details contained in the letter as attached to your e mail below to actively discuss the matter.

I see that this item is agenda number 4 for the meeting on Thursday. Please can you provide guidance as to what time we should attend so as to be able to make representations and listen to the considerations of the committee.
