SCHEDULE OF PROPOSED CONDITIONS

1. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system as per the minimum requirements of Westminster Police Licensing Team. All entry and exit points will be covered enabling frontal identification of every person entering in any light condition. The CCTV system shall continually record whilst the premises are open for licensable activities and during all times when customers remain on the premises. All recordings shall be stored for a minimum period of 31 days with date and time stamping. Viewing of recordings shall be made available immediately upon the request of Police or authorised officer throughout the preceding 31-day period.
2. There shall be no admission or readmission to the premises after 01:00 save for smokers.
3. Persons permitted to temporarily leave and re-enter the premises, e.g. to smoke, shall not be permitted to take drinks or glass containers with them.
4. (a) There shall be a minimum of two SIA door staff on duty after 19.00 who shall display their SIA licences at all times that the premises are open to the public.

(b) After 00.00 hours there shall be at least one SIA licensed staff (who shall be a full-time member of staff) monitoring outside of the premises and the duties shall include:
 - i. Supervise patrons arriving who are temporarily outside the premises, eg to smoke, to ensure that there is no public nuisance or obstruction of the public highway; *and*
 - ii. Remind patrons who are leaving not to congregate outside and to leave the area quietly.

5. From 00.00 hours Monday to Saturday until close of business, the premises shall only operate as a restaurant
 - i) In which customers are shown to their table
 - ii) Where the supply of alcohol is by waiter or waitress service only
 - iii) Which provides food in the form of substantial table meals that are prepared on the premises and are served and consumed at the table using non-disposable crockery
 - iv) Which do not provide any take away service of food or drink for immediate consumption
 - v) Which do not provide any take away service of food and drink and where
 - vi) Alcohol shall not be sold, supplied or consumed on the premises otherwise than to persons who are seated in the premises and bona fide taking substantial table meals there and provided always that the consumption of alcohol by such persons is ancillary to taking such meals
 - vii) Notwithstanding this condition customers are permitted to take from the premises part consumed and resealed bottles of wine supplied ancillary to their meal
6. Notwithstanding condition 5 licensable activities may be provided to persons attending a private or pre-booked function organised by the premises and which has been booked at least 24 hours in advance. A register of such events and details of persons attending will be kept for a period of 31 days and made available for inspection by the responsible authorities on request.
7. After 00.00 hours there shall be a personal licence holder on duty on the premises when the premises are authorised to sell alcohol.
8. After 00.00 hours patrons permitted to temporarily leave and then re-enter the premises, eg to smoke, shall not be permitted to take drinks or glass containers with them and shall be restricted to a maximum of 10 persons at any one time.
9. There shall be no sales of hot food or hot drink for consumption off the premises after 00.00 hours.

10. A challenge 21 proof of age scheme shall be operated at the premises where the only acceptable forms of identification are recognised photographic identification cards, such as a driving licence, passport or proof of age card with the PASS Hologram.
11. If available, the premises shall join the local Pubwatch or other local crime reduction scheme approved by the police, and local radio scheme.
12. The licence holder shall enter into an agreement with a hackney carriage and/or private carriage firm to provide transport for customers, with contact numbers made readily available to customers who will be encouraged to use such services.
13. Patrons waiting to leave by a taxi ordered from the premises are encouraged to wait inside the premises.
14. There shall be no striptease or nudity, and all persons shall be decently attired at all times, except when the premises are operating under the authority of a Sexual Entertainment Venue licence.
15. A direct telephone number for the manager at the premises shall be publicly available at all times the premises is open. This telephone number is to be made available to resident and businesses in the vicinity.
16. There shall be no payment made by or on behalf of the licence holder to any person for bringing customers to the premises.
17. No advertisements of any kind (including placard, poster, sticker, flyer, picture, letter, sign or other mark) that advertises or promotes the establishment, its premises, or any of its events, facilities, goods or services shall be inscribed or affixed upon the surface of the highway, or upon any building, structure, works, street furniture, tree or any other property, or be distributed to the public.
18. No person on behalf of the premises or on behalf of a person carrying or attempting to carry on a licensable activity shall cause, permit, employ or allow, directly or indirectly, whether on payment or otherwise, any person(s) to importune, solicit, or tout members of the public on any public highway within the specified area outlined below for the purpose of bringing customers to the premises. The distribution of leaflets or similar promotional material is also prohibited within the specified area. For the purpose of this section:

'Directly' means: - employ, have control of or instruct.

'Indirectly' means allowing / permitting the service of or through a third party.

'Specified Area' means the area encompassed within (insert name of boundary roads).

19. After 00:00 hours there will be a capacity reduction from 400 persons to 150 persons as to the basement and 150 persons as to the ground floor.
