

My name is Leila and I have been working at Sunset Strip in Soho since July 2015. I have been dancing on and off for over 11 years and Sunset Strip is by far the best club I have worked in. Not only are the clientele polite, respectful and easy to get along with, the other dancers are too.

There is a real sense of unity at Sunset Strip between the dancers and I have made many great life friends. The conversations we have in the changing rooms are some of the most diverse, interesting and engaging that I have had, not only compared to other stripclubs I have worked in but other working environments in general.

Sunset Strip feels like home for many of the dancers. Most dancers working there have been there for years, some decades. We all feel safe there and love that the dancing booths are out in the open so you never feel threatened.

It would be such a tragedy to close down one of London's oldest strip clubs and it would devastate all the people who have a life there.

"I have been working at Sunset Strip for approximately 5 years and the freedom and flexibility that sunset affords me is one of the most important aspects of the club. The fact we don't have to book shifts ensures that I can continue working in London, I would not be able to strip in any other licenced club in Central London as they all require a minimum number of shifts per week. I feel safe working there and whenever I have raised any issues with the security or management they have responded promptly and positively."
