### Hyde Park-

HPA- St James and St Michael's School Nursery, Sussex Gardens- as is

HPB- St John's Parish Hall, Hyde Park Crescent-as is

### Officer visits

International Community School – 21 Star Street

No rooms available on ground floor, classrooms are small and all located in the basement – no disabled access. Using one entrance will cause disruption to daily business.

Micky Star Community nursery – 61 St Michael's Street

Nursery Classrooms on the Ground Floor & Second Floor

First Floor used by WCC drop in Children's services

Disabled access - including lift within the building. Need to contact manager about viewing rooms. Nursery is used Monday to Friday 9am-6pm

Brunei Hall – Private student Halls of residence – 35-43 Norfolk Square

No disabled access

Not able to view rooms as manager is away

Norfolk Plaza Hotel – 29-33 Norfolk square

Disabled access -small detachable ramp for the front steps. There is a lift. They have one very small conference room in the basement. This room is too small to

accommodate voting- if the lift is not used – voters will find the stairway very narrow and quite steep. Using one entrance will cause disruption to daily business.

Praed Street is mainly small cafes shops – all commercial use

Paddington Basin, North Wharf Road, South Wharf Road, Merchant Square – All new developments of office buildings and residential use

Eastbourne terrace – Office buildings/New developments

The area has many small hotels – which do not have disabled access or halls/conference rooms for hire.
